William Barlow is the Deputy Director of the Integrated Information and Communication Technology (ICT) Support Directorate of the Office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Networks and Information Integration, Department of Defense Chief Information Officer (OASD(NII)/DoD CIO). His primary responsibilities include developing policy and guidance for Information Sharing between non-governmental and private organizations and the U.S. Government. Prior to this position, he served as an Information Technology (IT) Specialist (Policy) in the Architecture and Interoperability Directorate where he developed policy and guidance for business, logistics and medical system's Information Support Plans (ISPs).

Previously, Mr. Barlow served in the U.S. Air Force for over twenty-two years. During this time he served in a variety of communication and command positions through multiple organizational levels. His command positions included serving as the Deputy Support Group Commander at Incirlik Air Base, Turkey, supporting combat air operations over Northern Iraq and earthquake relief operations in Northern Turkey as well as at Thumrait Air Base, Oman, supporting combat air operations over Southern Iraq. His final active duty assignment was in the office of the Air Force CIO as the Deputy Director, Systems and Technology Directorate.

Mr. Barlow was born in Los Angeles, CA in 1957. He was commissioned in 1980 in the U. S. Air Force. He holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Criminology from the University of Maryland, a Master of Science Degree in Systems Management from the University of Southern California (1988), and a Master of Science Degree in Management Information Systems from the University of Arizona (1989). He is also a graduate of the U.S. Air Force's Air War College, the Armed Forces Staff College, and is a National Defense University Information Resource Management College certified CIO.
