Edmund Doray is the Chief of the Concepts and Technology Division in the Interagency Coordination Directorate at NORAD and USNORTHCOM. In that capacity Mr. Doray provides support to the Directorate and Commands related to concepts, innovation, technology and experimentation as they apply to the current operational gaps and anticipated needs. He has been at NORAD and US Northern Command working on capabilities development for the last 4 years. Mr. Doray also supports interagency engagement with the Department of Energy, National Laboratories, Department of Homeland Security, Department of Defense, Service Laboratories, National Guard Bureau, and others to foster communication and collaboration on technology and experimentation initiatives. Additionally, Mr. Doray serves as the co-chairperson of the Commands' Innovation and Technology Panel (ITP). The ITP provides a strategic-level look at N-NC requirements and assists the Commands in the review, development, sponsorship, and advocacy of S&T proposals needed to execute assigned missions.
