Ana B. Hinojosa is the Director, Field Operations for the El Paso Field Office of Customs and Border Protection (CBP). As the principal field manager for CBP operations, Ms. Hinojosa directs the activities of hundreds of employees, including CBP Officers, Agriculture Specialists and Import Specialists located at any one of the Ports of Entry within her area of responsibility, which include the Texas ports of El Paso, Fabens, Presidio and Fort Hancock and the New Mexico ports of Santa Teresa, Columbus, Antelope Wells and Albuquerque.

Prior to her assignment in El Paso, Ms. Hinojosa served as the Area Port Director at Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) and Dallas Fort Worth International (DFW), respectively. Prior to that, she held the position of Assistant Director, Operations for the South Texas CMC(Laredo FO), where she maintained operational oversight of the Texas border ports from Brownsville to Del Rio, and the airports of San Antonio and Austin. She also worked in the San Diego, CA area.

Ms. Hinojosa is originally from the Rio Grande Valley of Texas, and has spent most of her professional career, spanning more than 20 years, in various assignments along the US/Mexico Border. Ms. Hinojosa, has been a career member of the Senior Executive Service, is a graduate of Texas A&M International University with a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice.
