Dr. Cynthia Irvine is a Professor in the Department of Computer Science and Director of the Center for Information Systems Security Studies and Research (CISR) at the Naval Postgraduate School, where she has worked since 1994. A graduate of Rice and Case Western Reserve Universities, her research centers on the design and construction of high assurance systems and multilevel security. The author on over 150 papers and reports on cyber security, she has supervised over 120 Masters and PhD students. Dr. Irvine has served on numerous government computer and network security committees and review boards. Her memberships include: the ACM, ASP (life), and IEEE (Senior). She co-edits the education column of Security and Privacy magazine. A recipient of the Navy Information Assurance Award, she served as Vice Chair and then Chair of the IEEE Technical Committee on Security and Privacy from 2006 through 2009.
